3 Not later than October 1, 2018, the Administrator of 4 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (in this section referred to as "NASA") shall institute a process 5 to prioritize the recruitment of qualified candidates who are 6 women or individuals who are historically underrepresented 7 8 in the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) and computer science for internships and 9 10 fellowships at NASA with relevance to the aerospace sector 11 and related fields.
