1 **SEC. 423. REGIONAL INNOVATION PROGRAM.**

2 Section 27 of the Stevenson-Wydler Technology Inno-
3 vation Act of 1980 (15 U.S.C. 3722), is amended—

4 (1) by striking “clusters” each place it appears
5 and inserting “initiatives”;

6 (2) by striking “cluster” each place it appears
7 and inserting “initiative”;

8 (3) by striking “America COMPETES Reau-
9 thORIZATION Act of 2010” in subsection (d)(6)(B) and
10 subsection (g)(1) and inserting “FIRST Act of
11 2014”;

12 (4) in subsection (d)(7), by striking “2013”
13 and inserting “2015”;

14 (5) in subsection (d)(8), by striking
15 “\$7,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2011 through
16 2013” and inserting “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year
17 2014 and \$7,000,000 for fiscal year 2015”;

18 (6) in subsection (f)(2), by adding at the end
19 the following new subparagraph:

20 “(C) NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION.—

21 The Secretary shall enter into a memorandum

1 of understanding with the National Science
2 Foundation to ensure collaboration on shared
3 interests and complimentary responsibilities for
4 technological advancement from basic scientific
5 research.”; and

6 (7) in subsection (i), by striking “\$100,000,000
7 for each of fiscal years 2011 through 2013” and in-
8 serting “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2014 and
9 \$18,000,000 for fiscal year 2015”.
