

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4186**  
**OFFERED BY MR. LIPINSKI OF ILLINOIS**

Page 32, lines 4 through 11, amend section 120 to read as follows (and amend the table of contents accordingly):

**1 SEC. 120. STUDY OF ROTATOR PERSONNEL.**

2       The Board shall conduct a study on the effects of  
3 reducing the costs of employing individuals who are not  
4 permanent employees of the Foundation, including indi-  
5 viduals employed pursuant to the Intergovernmental Per-  
6 sonnel Act of 1970 (42 U.S.C. 4701 note). In the study,  
7 the Board shall evaluate methods to reduce costs for these  
8 employees, including expanded use of telework, greater  
9 cost sharing by outside institutions, and reviewing fringe  
10 benefit rates. The Board shall consider the impacts of  
11 such cost reduction policies, including the quality of man-  
12 agement in senior positions at the Foundation, the ability  
13 of the Foundation to fund cutting edge research, and the  
14 quality of programs operated by the Foundation. The  
15 Board shall provide a report to Congress with the findings  
16 of this study and a recommendation for policy changes not

1 later than 6 months after the date of enactment of this  
2 Act.
