4. SLAC National Accelerator Laboratory, a US Department of Energy FFRDC managed and operated by Stanford University.
5. SLAC National Accelerator Laboratory operates under a five year Management and Operating Contract between the DOE and Stanford University. This contract has been renewed or extended many times, and, thus, has been in place for many years. The funding for FY 2012 is approximately \$330,000,000.
6. While SLAC is a DOE-owned laboratory, I am an employee of Stanford University, the contractor that operates SLAC for DOE. For today's testimony, I do not purport to represent all of Stanford University, but just SLAC, the laboratory that Stanford manages on behalf of DOE.
8. SLAC receives more than 90% of its annual funds through the DOE Management and Operating Contract. The remaining amount is comprised of funding from non-federal entities or grants from other federal agencies.
